MYSTERY CHALLENGE QUILT:

STEP 2

So, you should have simple 9-patch blocks to work with this month. But note, the next steps are a little tricky, so pay close attention.

First, cut a 9-patch block down the center in both directions to create four 7" blocks (as illustrated in picture below). DO NOT MOVE ANY PIECES AS YOU MAKE THESE 2 CUTS.

Now, take a 7" square and press diagonally and/or mark a stitch line diagonally across it. Open and lay flat.

Next, place a 7" tone-on-tone square on each 9-patch section, with diagonal stitch line opposite to black corner piece, so that when stitched together the black square will be on the outside corner of the new block.

Stitch the 2 pieces together on your diagonal stitch line, and cut, open and press. NOTE: You will end up with 2 different sets of squares, 1 with a black square at top of triangle, and 1 with no black square.

Trim to 6-1/2".

Repeat until all 9-patches and have been cut and sewn to the 7" squares.
